Conditions of Entry

In the following 'we', 'our' or 'us' refers to the organisers, The Inland Waterways Association (IWA) Events Committee.

1. You agree that all information given on this form is complete and correct at the time the entry is submitted. You will advise any changes to us, in writing, as soon as possible. This entry covers the named craft or one unit (frame tent, motor home or caravan, etc) only. No transfers can be permitted without our written agreement. **REFUNDS WILL BE MADE ONLY AT OUR DISCRETION.**
2. We reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving any reason. Entries submitted by email will be automatically acknowledged.
3. Boat bookings - You confirm that you will hold third party insurance to a minimum amount of £1,000,000 for at least the period that the craft will be moored at the Event.
4. Boat Bookings - You agree to abide by all relevant bye-laws and license requirements of the navigation authority whilst the craft is moored at the Event. This includes displaying the correct craft license and satisfying the requirements of the Boat Safety Scheme.
5. You agree not to leave any litter, or cause pollution to the waterway, the towpath, the site or the surrounding area. This includes not discharging any toilets into the waterway and not leaving excrement from pets on the towpath, site or surrounding area.
6. You agree not to cause a nuisance to other people nearby, whether by excessive noise or any other activity. Boat Bookings - You agree not to store any equipment on the towpath or adjacent to it. Engines should be run to charge electrical systems only at times specified by the Waterspace Director.
7. You agree not to undertake any trading whatsoever, including advertising of boats, caravans or tents for sale etc., from the craft or camping unit covered by this entry. Entry forms for traders and exhibitors are available on request. You agree not to invite any news, or other media (including television companies) to report or film without our written agreement.
8. You agree not to store on your craft or take on site any article of an inflammable or explosive character (for example, fireworks). This is for public safety. Fuel and lubricants, as allowed for under the Boat Safety Scheme and gas cylinders and similar normally used for cooking and heating, etc, are permitted.
9. You agree to comply with our directions, including those of the Waterspace Director, the Campsite Manager and their teams. Our decision as to the allocation of moorings or campsite pitches and other arrangements is final. We reserve the right to move any craft from any mooring at any time before, during or after the Event and to moor craft using any appropriate mooring plan or arrangement. You agree not to change the mooring or campsite pitch allocated to you without the agreement of the Waterspace Director or Campsite Manager.
10. You accept that you are responsible at all times and in all places for the conduct of any children and pets attending the Event with you.
11. We will not be held responsible for any loss or damage, other than that to which we are legally liable as a result of our negligence. You should ensure that you have adequate insurance to cover any accidents or other losses. We will not be liable for any default due to any act of God, war, fire, flood, drought, tempest or other event beyond our reasonable control.
12. Block bookings will be accepted only if notified by an email that contains a list for boat bookings of each craft registration number or registered name or for campsite bookings of Surname and Post Code for each entry. A separate entry form should be completed for each entry and submitted by email on the same day.
13. All information provided by you will be stored in accordance with current legislation. A copy of this information can be made available to you on request. We promise not to sell your details to anyone else.
14. A limited number of moorings or pitches near the main site may be available for entries with registered disabled individuals attending. Applications for these moorings or pitches should be accompanied by proof of the registered disability (e.g. a copy of a document issued by a local authority for vehicle parking). We will try to satisfy reasonable requests as far as it is possible.
15. Entry prices shown overleaf include VAT at the standard rate, which at the date of printing this form is 20%. We reserve the right to amend these prices as a result of any changes to VAT. The tax point is the date when we receive this completed form.
16. Packs containing information about the Event, details of all awards, mooring and pitch locations will be sent out BY EMAIL during July. If you have not received your pack by the end of July 2016, please contact the Entries Officer. Preferably by email to event.entries@waterways.org.uk or by calling 01635 414567.
17. Plaques will be available @ £5.00 each when ordered and paid for in advance on this form. Plaques ordered after 15th July 2016 may be subject to a p&p supplementary charge of £2.50 These plaques will be dispatched in September.
18. Your booking fee is for your entire stay. This includes entry to evening entertainment for two people. Entry to the evening entertainment may be refused to anyone not wearing a properly fitted wristband.
19. Boat Bookings - Make sure you arrive with full water tanks and empty toilets. No arrangements are made for water supplies or Elsan disposal for boaters attending the Event. There will be rubbish disposal facilities on site.
20. Campsite Bookings - The Campsite will be open from 2pm Thursday 25th August 2016 and will close at 12 noon Tuesday 30th August 2016.
