There is currently a leak from the canal into the pub car park and due to the nature of the location and to minimise the impact on the running of the pub, we need a lot of person power to get the job done.

The task requires two trenches to be dug, a total length of 90 meters along the canal edge and then back filling with puddling clay to stop the leak. This is an opportunity to work with the construction team and is estimated to take 2 weeks to complete, but if we can muster up enough volunteers, to work alongside the construction team, we should reduce this time and spread the work load.

The job will commence in the next week or so therefore if you could spare a day or two or three or..... then that would be really ace.
